# WELCOME TO UNDERSTANDING DIABETES

Diabetes UK is currently working across South Yorkshire to improve awareness, prevention and care processes for people living with diabetes.

In Rotherham 17,516 people are living with diabetes. That is over 8% of the local population. But we know there are many more people living with pre-diabetes and at risk of developing type 2 diabetes.

In South Yorkshire, only 46.4% of people living with diabetes have access to the annual care processes they are entitled to.

Working in communities, you are in a unique position to signpost local people to diabetes support.

The Understanding Diabetes module will give you the confidence to talk to people about diabetes.

Further modules include type 2 diabetes remission, diabetes technology, diabetes and emotional health. Each module takes approximately 90 mins to complete, but they can be completed in stages, and people can get a certificate on completion to add to their training record or continued professional development portfolio. Although designed for non-specialist healthcare professionals they are a useful introduction for anyone working in the health system or community who wants to learn more about diabetes.
